

Installing Learning Ally Audiobooks

Install Learning Ally Audiobooks from your device's app store or from <u>LearningAlly.org/app</u>.

Using Learning Ally Audiobooks



1. Log in with your Learning Ally username and password. If you log in with single sign-on (SSO) credentials, select Sign on Through Your School or District or access the audiobook app through your single sign-on provider portal.



2. The bookshelf displays all of your audiobooks. Here you can view playback progress, downloaded books, view audiobook formats and add new books.



3. Select Add books or Browse to search for or discover new books. If your teacher assigned you a book, select Update My Books to see your new book assignments.

4. Use the navigation bar to play/pause, move between levels, rewind, fast forward. and customize playback and text settings.



5. Add bookmarks and notes using the Add Bookmark & Notes icon.



6. Use the in-app dictionary: Press and hold a word (mobile) or double click a word (computer). Highlight and take notes.



7. Navigate through the table of contents, jump to a page, access saved notes, bookmarks and vocabulary and customize your reading experience.



8. To delete a downloaded book or remove a book from your bookshelf, select the "i" on the book cover. To delete more than one downloaded book, select Delete My Books in your Profile and then select 🔀 next to the books that you want to delete and click Done.
